OBITUARY

Elizabeth Mary Mulondo was born on 15th December 1952, in Isikiro, Iganga District, Uganda, to the late Zakayo and Miriyeri Kagombero. She was the seventh of nine children. She studied at Buwaya Primary School and Tororo Girls School, for primary and secondary school respectively. She later attended Makerere University from 1975 – 1978, and then Kianda College, Nairobi, for post graduate secretarial studies.

She spent the majority of her career in the construction industry. From 1986 – 2006 she worked at the AAK Secretariat, where she received the AAK Long Service Achievement award in 2003. She joined Crown Paints PLC in 2012, where she worked diligently until her untimely death. She had a wealth of experience in Event & Conference organization and management spanning over twenty years. She partnered with other organizations (AAK, IQSK, ICPMK, BORAQS) for seminars, conventions, and other successful social and fundraising functions.

A God fearing Christian, Elizabeth was a dedicated member of ACK St. Barnabas, Lang'ata. She served in both the choir and Mothers Union, where she was a past Chairlady of St. Barnabas Choir and past Secretary of Mothers' Union of the same church. She was instrumental in organizing successful seminars and foreign trips for the two groups. At the time of her death she was the International Secretary for the Africa Project Against Suicide (APAS), where she championed against suicide to save lives.

Her charity knew no bounds, her doors wide open ready to receive and help anyone. School fees for poor children, a children's home in Runda, feeding programmes for slum children; her generosity was only limited by time. She had the most infectious energy, and a laugh that lit up every corner of the room. She lived a life full of love, adventure and a love for God that left everyone around her lighter and happier at all times. She will be sorely missed.

Elizabeth went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, 28th October 2020. She is survived by her husband Joseph, and her children Rachel, Samson, Timothy and Mercy, and her beautiful grandchildren, Babirye, Ethan and Grace.

Blessed Assurance


Blessed assurance, Jesus is mine Oh, what a foretaste of glory divine Heir of salvation, purchase of God Born of His spirit, washed in His blood


